Dalguise

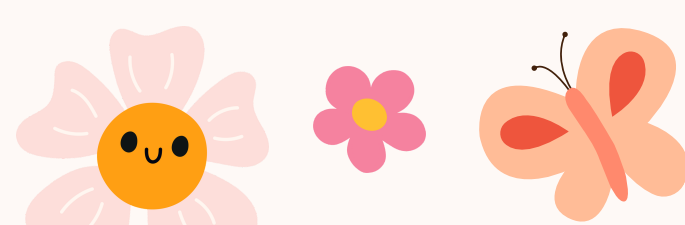

We said goodbye and Happy Retirement to Mr Smith our morning Janitor. We thank him for his dedication to keeping our school safe and in good order.

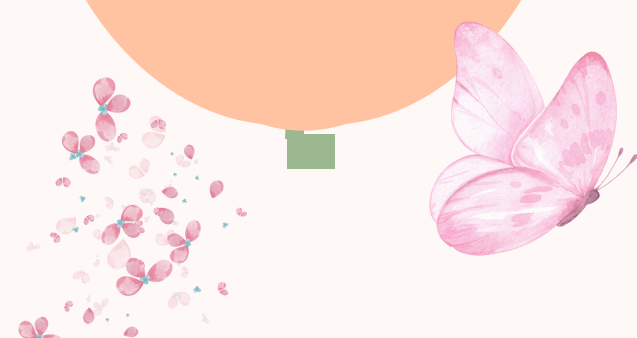
